Our keynote speaker is Jon Gordon who is also a consultant and author of the international bestsellers *The Energy Bus*, *The No Complaining Rule*, *Training Camp* and *The Shark and the Goldfish*. Jon is a graduate of Cornell University and holds a masters in teaching from Emory University. His passion for empowering educational leaders to create positive school environments is second to none.

- Presenter contact information: name, title, address, school name, phone and email address
- Proposed session title
- Session Type: lecture, panel, group discussion, etc.
- Preferred time: Wednesday morning or afternoon (see areas of interest*)
- Session Description: maximum 200 words
- Program Description: maximum 50 words, as you would have it appear in the conference program
- Learning outcomes: what do you want your audience to learn or achieve?
- Presenter credentials (applicable to the proposed session)

*Please note these **areas of interest**: School Leadership, Professional Learning Communities (PLC's); Best practice(s) in schools; Response to Intervention (RtI); Staff relations and/or Faculty meetings; Parent education/involvement and Community outreach; Discipline and Classroom Management techniques; Special education/Autism issues; and Technology in schools.

Selection preference is given to OASSP members. Vendor proposals **must** include participation/representation by a CCOSA member-administrator/practitioner and will only be considered if the vendor has a contract to exhibit at the conference (contracts are available by contacting Amanda Smith, amanda@ccosa.org).
