### **THE RANDALL RABURN LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP**

The Randall Raburn Scholarship is named for the current Executive Director of the Cooperative Council for Oklahoma School Administration (CCOSA) who has served from 1995-present. The endowed scholarship will annually award \$1,000.00 to a graduating senior who is the son or daughter of a CCOSA member.

This selection is based on academic excellence, leadership in school activities and/or work experience and community service. Each applicant must complete the attached application. Application must be typed. Each applicant is also asked to prepare a typewritten, double spaced paper telling of their career goal(s), why they chose their goal(s), and a well thought-out plan for achieving their goal(s). The paper should be no more than two pages in length.

Applicants need to collect three letters of recommendation from responsible adults who have observed their growth and development over a period of time. One should be by the High School Principal or someone familiar with your school accomplishments.

Applicants are required to submit to the CCOSA Office five (5) copies of the application materials. These materials include the completed application, pages 1-3; copies of transcripts of all academic work in grades 9-12; letters of recommendation and the paper on career goals as described in paragraph two. Please include one recent photo. The materials must be postmarked by **February 12, 2010**.

Selection will be made by a panel of CCOSA members chosen by the CCOSA Chairman and Executive Director. The decision of the panel shall be final.

The panel will select finalists who will be interviewed by the panel. One winner will be chosen. A check for \$1,000.00 will later be mailed to the college or university where the winner has been accepted for enrollment.

Travel expenses to and from the interview must be paid by the applicant. CCOSA cannot pay these costs.
